DROP OFF & PICK UP



We will be at our usual site, which can be found on Google Maps by searching "**Alfresco Outdoors.**" Please meet the site manager under our gazebo.

If you are running late or have any issues on the day, please contact the Writtle site manager on **07743 301141**.

At drop-off, parents/carers will be given a numbered token for each child. This number must be provided at pick-up (especially if someone else is collecting) as part of our safeguarding procedures.

Drop-off: 8:00–9:00am

Pick-up: 5:00–6:00pm

WHAT TO BRING

What Your Child Needs to Bring

- Food for the day*
- Refillable water bottle
- Strong, closed-toe shoes (no sandals or Crocs etc.)

If cold or raining:

- Raincoat
- Warm layer

If sunny or warm:

- Sun cream
- Sun hat



***We do not provide food. Children will have two snack breaks and one lunch break, so please pack enough food to give lasting energy, as they will be more active than on a normal school day.**

Drinking water is available on site to refill bottles.

WEATHER



We plan for all weather. While Max will be doing his best sun dance, please assume **outdoor activities will continue in light rain**, with waterproofs on. Weather can change quickly, so please **check the forecast for your booked days** and ensure your child is dressed appropriately. In the event of **severe weather**, we have access to indoor space.

GROUPS



Once everyone has arrived, children are organised into age-appropriate groups. They are given the opportunity to be with friends, including across age groups if they wish, before being placed into small, supervised groups of **no more than 12**.

MEDICATION



We can only administer medication that has been **sent in by parents/carers with their child**, including antihistamines and pain relief.

Emergency medication (e.g. inhalers) may be kept with the child or held by their instructor, **at the parent's discretion**.
